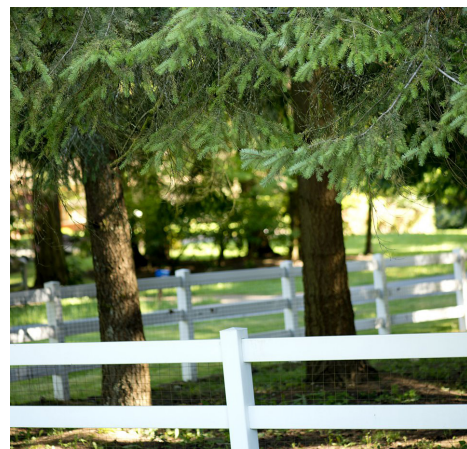
Bridle Trails: Keeping it Rural - Pam Johnston

Bridle Trails is known for its rural and equestrian character. How does that come into play for projects in Neighborhood Enhancement Project (NEP) program? This fall, the City of Bellevue will guide Bridle Trails residents to create projects to enhance our neighborhood. One of the screening criteria will be how each project enhances the character of our neighborhood. Given a fund of \$370,000, there may be more than one project that can be completed.

How is the character for Bridle Trails expressed? Come and see different perspectives experts.

- Jennifer Duncan, president of the Lake Washington Saddle Club will address what it means to be an equestrian community.
- Christine Hemnes and Laura Polt will address what brings people to Bridle Trails and why people leave, from a real estate perspective.
- City of Bellevue Land Use and David Berg from Transportation will explain the City framework that supports the Bridle Trails neighborhood and give us perspectives on how a planner or engineer uses the plans/codes in their work.

On May 8, the City of Bellevue, issued the Phase 2 Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) on the proposed PSE project. See www.EnergizeEastsideEIS.org. PSE continues to assert that there is a need for the project. The Coalition of Neighborhoods for Sensible Energy (CENSE) continues to analyze PSE information and concludes that there is no need for the proposed project. See cense.org for more information.

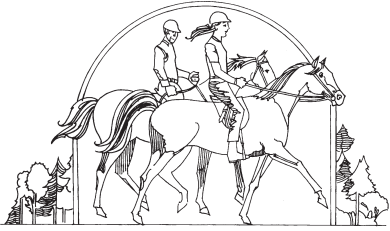
The City will review the comments
